EXPLANATORY NOTES

- 4,308 students (with a Male/Female ratio 48/52%) are now freely attending eight Full Elementary Schools where, prior to 2005 and A-CET/EYES school re-building project work, few places existed.
- In 2014, 262 students from four of these schools (#1, #4, #5 & #7) took their Grade 9 National examination and 96% passed to Secondary School (10 failed or dropped out).
- Additionally five schools run Kindergarten (pre-school) classes on an informal community support basis. These registration/attendance figures: 156 with 62M/94F) are not included.
- These nine Bureau of Education run schools have a potential capacity for over 10,000 students attending on two (day) shifts.
- All schools are equipped with basic local made furniture, have mains or solar electricity installed plus on-site dry latrines. Additionally all schools have on-site access to harvested water - provided by other charities.
- Classroom capacities are officially 50, but often circumstances dictate that they have to accommodate more.
- Ziban Albe School now also accommodates 500 Grade 9 students (245 M/255 F)
